- Vendor will sell appropriate goods; no explosive objects, open flames, fireworks or objectionable material, or anything counterfeit or illegal
- Must bring your own tables, chairs, tent and displays
- Vendor must remain at show all day 12 pm – 9 pm – No early breakdown
- Other items as listed on the Vendor Guidelines form.

No entry will be considered for acceptance unless accompanied by all required forms, fees & photos (*new vendors*). Vendor Information & Festival Guidelines

- No vehicles will be allowed in the festival area later than 1 hour prior to starting time. Due to the nature of vendor load-in, there is a strict limit of one vehicle per vendor space during load-in. Bringing more than one vehicle may cause you to lose your assigned load-in time as it can delay other vendors from setting up.
- Vendors shall remain open until the end of the festival. No vehicles shall be allowed in the festival area ½ hour after the official closing of the festival as this creates a huge safety concern to attendees & fellow vendors. The safety of all participants is the festival's utmost concern.
- The Day of the Dead Fest is an outdoor event and will proceed rain or shine! No refunds for rainouts or rollovers. Vendors/Exhibitors are responsible for protection of their exhibits from the rain.
- Vendors are responsible for their own set-up and supplies needed. You must bring your own tent, tables and chairs. Festival personnel are not responsible for helping with booth setup.
- All tents must be firmly secured to the ground to prevent hazard in the event of high winds.
- The Day of the Dead Festival will have hired security. The City of Bay City cannot be held liable for loss or damage to arts and crafts or vendor products or to injury to anyone participating in the event.
- Vendor parking information will be sent with the set-up instructions in October. Parking for vendors/exhibitors is available near the festival. Vendor vehicles may not remain within the festival area.
- Booth rental fees must be paid upon reservation.
- After the 10th of October, only payments accepted will be cash or credit card, no checks.
- Bring plenty of your own change. We do not have the ability to supply you with change.
